## **Species Features**

It's important to pick the right wood for your project. The table below shows the key features of each species.

| Species          | Features  | Species  | Features   |

| Ash              | Strength, durability, and attractive grain.                                       | Elm      | Interlocking grain patterns, strength, and durability.                 |
| Beech            | Pale colour, tight grain, and smooth texture.                                     | Oak      | Strength, durability, attractive grain patterns and stains well.       |
| Cedar            | Distinctive aroma, resistant to decay and insects.                                | Pine     | Coarse-grained and usually dark-coloured.                              |
| Cherry           | Rich colour that darkens over time and smooth grain patterns.                     | Sycamore | Distinctive appearance with interlocking grain patterns.               |
| Chestnut (Horse) | Soft and lightweight.   | Walnut   | Dark, rich colour and straight grain.                                  |
| Chestnut (Sweet) | Distinctive grain pattern. A light to medium brown colour that darkens over time. | Yew      | Durable, attractive appearance, and distinctive grain characteristics. |
