Treatment of timber

Correctly caring for timber furniture will help to preserve its natural beauty and ensure its longevity. Here are our tips for the treatment of timber to ensure it looks its best:

- Keep it clean by regularly dusting the furniture with a soft, lint-free cloth to remove dust and debris.
- Avoid using harsh cleaners or abrasive materials that can damage the surface.
- Position the furniture away from spills, leaks or humid environments to protect it from moisture.
- Use coasters or placemats to protect the surface from moisture and heat.
- Apply a suitable protective finish to the wood surface to protect it from stains, scratches, and UV damage.
- Position the furniture away from direct sunlight to prevent fading over time.
- Inspect the furniture for any signs of damage, wear or discolouration. Repair the affected areas to prevent further damage.
- Avoid dents by not placing any heavy or sharp objects directly on the furniture surface.
- Use felt pads under furniture legs to protect the wood surface.

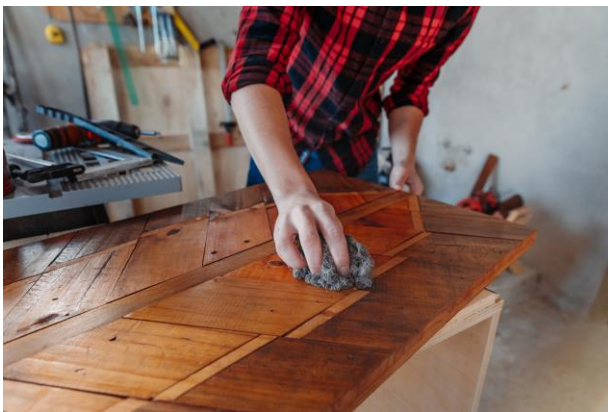
